### **Learning resources**

Use the immense buying power of the SDF to create a library of resources, or buy site licences for web-based training material. Investigate e-learning: the DfES was suggested as a good practitioner.

### **Skills Sharing**

Organise some skills development to be delivered regionally on a quarterly basis, eg appreciative enquiry.

### **HEaTED**

Follow this up – expectations have been raised and need to be met.

### **Representation on SDF**

How representative is SDF? What about other categories of staff being represented?

### **Trade Unions and Union Learning Reps**

There is a need to train up new ULRs. Could this be organised on a regional basis? There also needs to be an acknowledgement that more is required than basic skills training.

### **Communication Strategy**

Information in and out needs to be concentrated – there is a plethora of different places to look. The SDF website is not a first port of call, if at all.
