5. What is the transcendental unity of apperception? Of what importance is it in Kant's thought?
6. EITHER (a) Critically assess Kant's notion of 'transcendental illusion.'

OR (b) With reference to one of the Antinomies, discuss Kant's views about the use and misuse of reason.
7. Does Kant succeed in showing that reason cannot establish the existence of a deity?
8. Outline and evaluate Kant's claims about the freedom of the will.
9. According to Kant, in what sense, if any, might my getting pleasure out of doing my duty to help people in trouble detract from the moral worth of such actions?
10. Explain and discuss Kant's notion of a 'kingdom of ends.'
11. Critically examine Kant's conception of beauty.

12. Can Kant explain how it is possible for the mature critic to have a better appreciation of a poem than does its youthful author?
