4. In what sense, according to Nietzsche, does science still embody the ascetic ideal?
5. What is Nietzsche's assessment of the value of Art and did that evaluation remain constant throughout his work?
6. Does Nietzsche simply reject the notion of free will or does he give a revisionary account of it?
7. Does Nietzsche reject the notion of a unified self?
8. What is Nietzsche's theory of the will to power supposed to explain? How successful is it?
9. Assess Nietzsche's critique of pity.
10. Why does Nietzsche disapprove of regret? Is he right to do so?
11. What, if anything, is lost if we attempt to separate the content of Nietzsche's philosophy from his style?
12. Is Nietzsche a naturalist?
