AND UPON consideration of the First, Second and Third Defendants’ application to extend time dated of 23 December 2024

AND UPON the First, Second and Third Defendants, and the Claimant, having agreed to the terms of this order

BY CONSENT IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT: -

1. The case management conference listed in a 3-day window from the 28 January 2025 with a time estimate of half a day is vacated.
2. The Claimant to have permission to file and serve a reply to the Defence by 4pm on 31 January 2025.
3. A case and costs management conference shall be listed on the first available date after 7 April 2025 with a time estimate of half a day.
4. Because this Order has been made without a hearing, the parties have the right to apply to have the order set aside, varied or stayed. A party making such an application must send or deliver the application to the court (together with any appropriate fee) to arrive within 7 days of service of this Order.
5. Costs in the case.
6. The Claimant shall serve this Order on the Defendants.
