1. Definitions

In this scheme:

"the beneficiaries" mean members of the University of London.

"the University" means the University of London.

"award" and "awards" means any prize, grant, reward or mark of distinction made by the Trustee in furtherance of the objects of the Funds.

"the charities" means the charities identified in the schedule to this scheme.

"the Commission" means the Charity Commission for England and Wales.

"the Prize Fund" means the University of London Prize Fund created by clause 2(2) of this scheme.

"the Research Fund" means the University of London Research Fund created by clause 2(4) of this scheme.

"the Studentship Fund" mean the University of London Studentship Fund created by clause 2(3) of this scheme.

"the Funds" means the Prize Fund, the Research Fund, and the Studentship Fund and "Fund" means one of the Funds.

"the former trusts" means the scheme of the Commission of 18 September 2006 and the documents (those of which details are known) that are listed in the schedule to this scheme.

"the trustee" means the trustee of the Funds acting under this scheme.

ADMINISTRATION

2. Administration

- (1) The charities are to be administered in accordance with this scheme. This scheme replaces all the former trusts of the charities.
- (2) The charities identified by numbers 1 to 28 of the schedule to this scheme are to be administered as one charity. The name of the charity will be the University of London Prize Fund.
- (3) The charities identified by numbers 29 to 55, 63 and 67 of the schedule to this scheme are to be administered as one charity. The name of the charity will be the University of London Studentship Fund.

- (4) The charities identified by numbers 56 to 62 and 64 to 66 of the schedule to this scheme are to be administered as one charity. The name of the charity will be the University of London Research Fund.

PROVISIONS COMMON TO THE FUNDS

POWERS OF THE TRUSTEE

3. Powers of the trustee

In addition to any other powers which it has, the trustee may exercise the following powers in furtherance of the objects of the charity:

- (1) Power to delegate the performance of any act, including the exercise of any power or discretion, to a committee appointed by the trustee, or to any one or more members of the trustee's Collegiate Council. The committee and/or members of the Collegiate Council must promptly report their acts and proceedings to the trustee. The committee and/or members of the Collegiate Council must not incur expenditure on behalf of the charity except in accordance with a budget previously agreed by the trustee.
- (2) Power to make rules (which must be consistent with this scheme) for awards including the terms of the award and the method of selecting candidates for benefit.
- (3) Power to connect an award with the name of a former benefactor, or with any other name.

TRUSTEE

4. Trustee

The University of London is the trustee of the charity.

OBJECTS

5. Object of the Prize Fund

The object of the Fund is, for the public benefit, to advance the education of the beneficiaries by the giving of prizes, grants, rewards or marks of distinction to beneficiaries.

6. Object of the Research Fund

The object of the Fund is, for the public benefit, to advance the education of the beneficiaries by the giving of grants to enable them to undertake or continue research at or within the University.

7. Object of the Studentship Fund

The object of the Fund is, for the public benefit, to advance the education of the beneficiaries by the provision of studentships.

CHARITY PROPERTY

8. Use of income and capital

- (1) For each Fund the trustee must firstly apply:
 - (a) the income of the Fund; and
 - (b) if the trustee thinks fit, its expendable endowment; and
 - (c) when the expenditure can properly be charged to it, its permanent endowmentin meeting the proper costs of administering each Fund and of managing its assets.
- (2) After payment of these costs, the trustee must apply the remaining income in furthering the objects of each Fund.
- (3) The trustee may also apply for the objects of each Fund its:
 - (a) expendable endowment; and
 - (b) permanent endowment, but only on such terms, including for the replacement of the amount spent, as the Commission may approve by order in advance.

GENERAL PROVISION

9. Questions relating to the Scheme

The Commission may decide any question put to it concerning:

- (1) the interpretation of this scheme; or

(2) the propriety or validity of anything done or intended to be done under it.
