Additional costs

You should also budget for the fee charged by your local examination centre. Examination centre fees are not included within the fees set out above. This fee will vary from centre to centre and you should contact your proposed examination centre(s) for details of their fees to factor them in to the overall cost of completing the programme. You can find contact details for all our [examination centres](#) on the website. The University of London is only responsible for the examination centre fee charged at London centres. You will be charged £81 per sitting when using London examination centres.

You should also budget for tuition costs if studying at a recognised teaching centre.

Goods and Services Tax (GST)

The University is required to add Goods and Services Tax (GST) certain fees paid by students resident in certain countries. Further information can be found on our [web page](#).

LSHTM Fee Schedule

All student fees shown are net of any local VAT, Goods and Services Tax (GST) or any other sales tax payable by the student in their country of residence. Where the University is required to add VAT, GST or any other sales tax at the local statutory rate, this will be added to the fees shown during the payment process. For students residing in the UK, our fees are exempt from VAT.

Programme Fees may be paid in one of two ways:

- either a single payment, covering the application and registration fees and all module fees for the programme or stand-alone Individual module;
- or the application and registration fees plus the fees for the modules you select to study in the first year. To complete your registration, you must pay at the same time both the registration fee and the fee for at least one module. In subsequent years, only the fees for any new modules are payable.

When to pay

- The application fee (non-refundable) is payable when you make your application for an MSc, PGDip, PGCert or Individual modules taken on a standalone basis. If your application is successful, you will receive an offer inviting you to register.
- The Programme Fees above refer to the 2021-2022 session only and are effective from 1 December 2020.
- Registration and module/dissertation fees must be paid no later registration deadlines. Registration deadlines will be available from 01 January 2021
- The full course fee for Pharmacoepidemiology and Pharmacovigilance must be paid by the registration deadline.
- The examination resit fee, payable when entering for an examination to resit a previously failed module, is payable by 1 February in the year of examination.
- If you are permitted to transfer to the MSc degree from the Postgraduate Certificate or Postgraduate Diploma, you will not normally be required to pay a new registration fee for the MSc degree, but will be required to pay the appropriate remaining module fees as applicable.
- If you are permitted to proceed from an Individual module taken on a stand-alone basis to an award, you will be required to pay the relevant registration fee and the fee for the remaining modules.
