Study spaces

Our reading rooms and individual study desks on floors 4-7 do not need to be booked. The group study rooms, the accessibility suite and the private study carrels can be booked on our website. Library members also have access to BLOOM@Senate House, a social study space and café on the lower ground floor with bookable group study rooms and facilities to refill water containers.

Finding books and material

Search the catalogue on the Library's website to discover what we have and where to find it. Items marked 'Stack Service' can be ordered by clicking on the 'Request it' button. Items are normally

delivered within a few hours. Items housed off-site may take 24-48 hours. Online journals and eBooks can be accessed through the catalogue or the A-Z list of databases.

Library staff are present in the fourth floor Membership and Service Hall during staffed hours and via live chat online Monday to Friday 09:00-17:00.
